## Local PODS Moving and Storage Lends a Hand-Up for the 4th Annual Santa Barbara Veteran Stand Down

**(SANTA MARIA, Calif.)** – Oct. XX, 2015 – For the many veterans who are left without the daily amenities that so many people take for granted, local PODS Moving and Storage leader is lending a hand-up by donating the use of its PODS containers to Santa Barbara County’s “Veteran Stand Down” on Saturday, Oct.17, from 9 a.m.-2 p.m. The drive serves local veterans in need of clothing, haircuts, household items, food, hygiene products and other services.

For the month of October, a PODS® Container was placed at Santa Maria Fairpark to serve as a collection point for their weekly clothing and hygiene products that were donated.

“The donation of the PODS container gives us the ability to collect and store more donations while providing us a safe and secure place before they are transported to the event where we distribute goods to the veterans,” said Sandy Agalos, Stand Down Coordinator. “It’s the key to our success because it saves us a lot in moving and storing costs by allowing us to put our community donations towards food and transportation costs for follow-up appointments among other expenses.”

At the Stand Down event, veterans, their children and spouses will be offered various services, such as showers, dental exams, PTSD counseling, and breakfast and lunch. They will have access to substance abuse programs, health services organizations and with career centers. Over 150 organizations have agreed to aid the event, including People’s Self-Help Housing and the California Department of Veteran Affairs.

“PODS is always willing to help the veterans who have served our country in any way that we can,” said Steve Yapp, owner of local PODS Moving and Storage. “Taking part in the Veterans Stand Down event these past few years is not only an honor, but a privilege to be a part of such an event that does so much for our veterans.”
